

Admission Requirements for the College of Science

The applicant must have a high school diploma in the scientific branch from Iraqi schools or an equivalent certificate, validated by the Directorate General of Education in the province. Admission is based on the specific acceptance rates for each department, where scientific departments are chosen according to the students' grades in the year of admission, in addition to their preferences. The acceptance results for the different departments are announced after conducting competition among students based on their grades and preferences. Accepted students in the College of Science will follow the Bologna process, which aims to enhance the reputation of universities and the Iraqi educational system internationally. It also involves designing new curricula that meet labor market needs and improve employment opportunities for graduates.

Educational Outputs

The college provides a conducive environment to achieve excellence in education within the fields of life sciences, physics, chemistry, mathematics, earth sciences, computer science, biological technologies, astronomy and space, remote sensing, and geographic information systems.
